3. Mr and Mrs M. Clare have sought the Parish Council's approval for the stopping up of that part of Dolesden Lane that leads to Turville Court, the creation of a new bridleway to the north of that part of Dolesden Lane and the upgrading of part of the public footpath across Summer Heath and Summerheath Wood to a bridleway (see proposals and related map, dated 22 September 2010).

On 22 September 2010, the Parish Council agreed to seek the views of the community on the proposal. That consultation was completed prior to the Parish Council meeting on 12 January 2011.

Taking into account the results of the consultation and other information received since 22 September 2010, the Parish Council is to consider the following two, separate resolutions.

a) Resolution 1

To approve the proposed stopping up of part of Dolesden Lane, the creation of a bridleway and the upgrading of a public footpath to a bridleway as set out in the proposal dated 22 September 2010, subject to the conditions agreed by the Parish Council in November 2005 but modified to reflect the change in ownership of Turville Court and information obtained during the course of the consultation.

b) Resolution 2

To approve the creation of a bridleway and the upgrading of a public footpath to a bridleway as set out in the proposal dated 22 September 2010 but without the proposed stopping up of part of Dolesden Lane.
