The South West Chilterns and Marlow Local Area Forum (LAF) is attended by local county, district and parish councillors, along with representatives from Police, Fire and Rescue, and other public and voluntary sector partners. They meet regularly to discuss local residents' issues and priorities, which then help to make up the Local Area Plan. The last Local Area Plan for this area highlighted the following priorities:

- Public Transport particularly in rural areas;
- Maintenance and upgrading of village halls and community centres;
- Affordable Housing;
- Leisure Activities for young children and young people;
- Anti-Social Behaviour (in some locations);
- Maintenance and upgrading of village halls
- Hospitals and health

These priorities now need to be reviewed and the LAF would like as many residents as possible to help identify a fresh set of local priorities. A short survey has been developed by Community Impact Bucks in partnership with Bucks
